- 2. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
- 3. The faculty of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
- 4. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- 5. This MOU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
- 6. Either party should have the right to terminate this MOU upon 50 days prior written notice to the other Party.
