MOU

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on this 8th August 2018 between:

Sir C R Reddy College of Engineering, Eluru, and Andhra Pradesh, India, represented by its principal, **Dr.G.Samba Siva Rao**, here in after referred to as **Sir CRRCOE**.

AND



SAMATA Degree College, Sector 10, MVP Colony, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh-530017 represented by its **Director Dr. B. Murali Krishna**, here in after referred to as **SDC**

Both **Sir CRRCOE** and **SDC** are collectively referred to as the Parties and individually as a Party.

WHEREAS, **Sir CRRCOE** is an institution offering various undergraduate and postgraduate programs in engineering disciplines with state-of-the-art infrastructure and facilities;

WHEREAS, **SDC** is an institution offering various undergraduate programs in management sciences disciplines with state-of-the-art infrastructure and facilities;

WHEREAS, both the Parties are committed to enhancing the quality of engineering education , management science and research through collaboration and cooperation;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Objectives

The objectives of this MOU are:

- To conduct joint FDPs, workshops, seminars, both national and International Conferences on topics of mutual interest and relevance.
- To share the resources, expertise and best practices of both the institutions.
- To facilitate the participation of faculty members and students of both the institutions in the FDPs, workshops and seminars, both National and International Conferences conducted by either institution.
- To explore the possibilities of joint research projects, consultancy services and publications.

2. Scope

The scope of this MOU covers the following areas:

- **FDPs:** The Parties will jointly organize FDPs on emerging topics and technologies in engineering disciplines. The FDPs will be designed to enhance the knowledge, skills and competencies of the faculty members of both the institutions. The FDPs will be conducted either online or offline or in a blended mode as per the convenience and availability of the resource persons and participants. The duration, frequency, venue, fees, certificates and other details of the FDPs will be decided mutually by the Parties.
- **Workshops:** The Parties will jointly organize workshops on practical aspects and applications of engineering concepts and tools. The workshops will be aimed at providing hands-on experience and exposure to the faculty members and students of both the institutions. The workshops will be conducted either online or offline or in a blended mode as per the convenience and availability of the resource persons and participants. The duration, frequency, venue, fees, certificates and other details of the workshops will be decided mutually by the Parties.
- **Seminars:** The parties will jointly organize seminars on current issues and trends in engineering domains. The seminars will be intended to provide a platform for sharing ideas, insights and experiences among the faculty members and students of both the institutions. The seminars will be conducted either online or offline or in a blended mode as per the convenience and availability of the resource persons and

participants. The duration, frequency, venue, fees, certificates and other details of the seminars will be decided mutually by the Parties.

- **Research and Incubation Cell:** The parties will explore the possibilities of undertaking joint research projects, consultancy services and publications in the areas of mutual interest and relevance. The parties will identify the research topics, objectives, methodology, funding, timeline, deliverables and other aspects of the research projects. The parties will also seek to publish the research outcomes in reputed journals and conferences. The parties will share the intellectual property rights, benefits and responsibilities arising from the research activities as per the agreed terms and conditions.
- **Exchange:** The parties will facilitate the exchange of faculty members and students for participating in the FDPs, workshops and seminars conducted by either party. The parties will also encourage the exchange of faculty members and students for pursuing research projects, consultancy services and publications. The parties will provide the necessary support and assistance to the visiting faculty members and students in terms of accommodation, transportation, access to facilities and resources, etc. The parties will also recognize the credits earned by the visiting faculty members and students as per the norms and regulations of their respective institutions.
- **National and International Conferences:** The parties will jointly organize National and International Conferences on current issues and trends in engineering domains. The background and context of the conference, such as the theme, objectives, expected outcomes, target audience. The roles and responsibilities of each party involved in the conference, such as the organizers, sponsors, speakers, participants. The terms and conditions of the collaboration, such as the duration, budget, resources, communication, reporting, evaluation. The signatures and dates of the authorized representatives of each party.

3. Coordination:

The parties will appoint a coordinator from each institution to oversee the implementation of this MOU. The coordinators will be responsible for:

- Communicating with each other on a regular basis to plan, execute and monitor the activities under this MOU.
- Liaising with the respective authorities, departments, faculty members and students of their institutions to facilitate the smooth functioning of the activities under this MOU.
- Resolving any issues or disputes that may arise during the course of this MOU.

- Preparing and submitting periodic reports on the progress and outcomes of the activities under this MOU.

4. Duration

This MOU will come into effect from the date of signing by both the parties and will remain valid for a period of ONE year from **August 2018 to August 2019**. The parties may extend or renew this MOU by mutual consent in writing before the expiry of this MOU.

5. Termination

Either party may terminate this MOU by giving an advance written notice of three months to the other party. The termination of this MOU will not affect the ongoing activities under this MOU, unless otherwise agreed by both the parties.

6. Amendment

This MOU may be amended by mutual consent of both the parties in writing. Any amendment to this MOU will be signed by both the parties and will form part of this MOU.





7. Arbitration

If the dispute or difference remains unresolved after 30 days of consultation and negotiation, then it will be referred to arbitration by a sole arbitrator appointed by mutual consent of both the parties. The arbitration will be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof. The venue of arbitration will be Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh. The language of arbitration will be English. The award of the arbitrator will be final and binding on both the parties.

8. Miscellaneous

- This MOU is not intended to create any legal or contractual obligations or liabilities on either party.
- This MOU is not intended to confer any rights or benefits on any third party.
- This MOU is subject to the laws of India and the jurisdiction of the courts at Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh.
- This MOU is executed in two originals, one for each party.

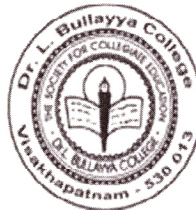

SAMATA DEGREE COLLEGE represented by its **Director & In charge Principal** (Here in after refer to as “**SDC**”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean & include its successors & assigns) being the party of first part.

And

NYAYA VIDYA PARISHAD LAW COLLEGE represented by its **Principal** (Here in after refer to as “**NVPLC**”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean & include its successors & assigns) being the party of second part
“**SDC**” & “**NVPLC**” are here in after, wherever the context so requires, individually referred to as “party” and collectively as “parties”.

Whereas:

A. **SDC** is engaged in service of Arts, Science, Commerce & Management Education with college name referred as **SAMATA DEGREE COLLEGE, Visakhapatnam.**

B. **NVPLC** is engaged in service of 44 years with college name referred as **NYAYA VIDYA PARISHAD LAW COLLEGE** in Visakhapatnam District.

I. OBJECTIVES OF MOU:

1. To promote & enhance academic interest between **NVPLC** and **SDC**.
2. To provide advice for implementation of quality of education between **NVPLC** and **SDC**.
3. To promote research /continuing education activities between parties.
4. Access to Information on Mercantile Law, Business Law, Labor Laws.
5. Access to Centers of Excellence of the college
6. Technical support in projects related to Laws from senior faculty or experts.

7. Guidance for specific issues in terms of Memorandum of understanding from the senior faculty or experts.
8. To refer or depute faculty for specific programs as Resource persons.

II. TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION:

- A. A continuing quality improvement program to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.
- B. Providing academic interaction by delivering special lectures at both Institutes on topics of relevance to modern industry.
- C. Provide necessary help in organizing workshops, conferences and personality development programs at both parties for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- D. To provide training programs for Students & Staff.

III. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The cost of development of infrastructure at both parties should be borne by themselves.
2. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
3. The faculty and students of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
4. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
5. This MOU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
6. Either party should have the right to terminate this MOU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other Party.

A. CONFIDENTIALITY:

The NVPLC and SDC agreed to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data processed by either party before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

B. COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf who will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

C. TENURE AND TERMINATION

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for **Two years**, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the other institution 30 days in advance.




However, NVPLC and SDC will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.
